Since the 2018 Farm Bill removed hemp and derivatives containing no more than 0.03% THC from Schedule I of the Controlled Substances Act, it seems that hemp-derived CBD products are everywhere. Sales and growth figures for the CBD industry are staggering and with that a lot of potential advertising revenue. But decisions to take CBD advertising must be made with an understanding that the legal status of CBD-infused food, beverages and dietary supplements remains unsettled and confusing. Bills On The Hill

AMFM Act

Performance Tax legislation is back in the form of the Ask Musicians for Music (AMFM) Act, introduced in the House & Senate last week. The AMFM Act gives music creators control by requiring broadcasters to obtain consent before playing their music. Read Radio Ink article www.noperformancetax.org

STELAR

House Energy and Commerce committee passed a renegotiated version of STELAR last week. To summarize, NAB & State Broadcast Associations have been fighting all year to let STELA sunset, legislation from the '80s that gives DirecTV subsidies to carry major market newscasts in 12 markets instead of their local newscasts.
