WVTK's Cash For Paws Radiothon Raises \$23,000 for Addison County's Homeward Bound!



When WVTK's Bruce Zeman wrapped up the 2022 "Bruce & Hobbes Ca\$h for Paws" Radiothon April 21st, he had raised \$11,500, almost double his goal, all to benefit Homeward Bound, Addison County's Humane Society.

Then, New Haven firefighter Roger Hamilton called "The Wake-Up Crew with Bruce & Friends" with an unexpected offer to match, bringing the total to \$23,000 and shattering the previous high of \$7,861 set in 2021!

"We are so grateful for Roger's generosity. I'm not sure he realizes what a big deal this is." said Homeward Bound's Development Director Hannah Manley. Zeman added "Roger's generosity shows the kind of person he is - a class act!"

For the seventh consecutive time, Zeman, accomplished what he set out to do; raise money to help local animals with help from his sidekicks Zoey & Calvin. With the passing of Hobbes, his long-time co-host, in July 2020, an emotional Zeman dedicated this year's radiothon to his best friend. "I do this for Hobbes so more animals like him get the second chance he did," Zeman said.

Created in 2009 by Zeman, "Bruce & Hobbes' Ca\$h for Paws" is an annual radiothon held on 92.1 WVTK in Middlebury to generate money for the Middlebury-based animal shelter. Zeman goes LIVE for 24 consecutive hours and plays ANY song requested for a \$10 donation.

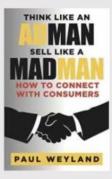
