Greg Towne Retires After 22 Years at WVNY



April 2001, George W. Bush was three months into the White House, Tom Brady had just finished his rookie season with the Patriots and Greg Towne went to work in the Engineering Department of a TV station on Shelburne Road – ABC 22. Fittingly, 22 years later, Greg is calling it a career and what a career it was!

Greg worked in the studio and the transmitter site, but did more than just keep the station on the air. He helped maintain the equipment, the cars...and shoveled *a lot* of snow.

Greg was there when ABC 22 and Fox 44 got joined at the hip and helped move the station from Shelburne Road to where it is now, atop Water Tower Hill in Colchester. He didn't just move a station, he moved a whole transmitter from the old building on Mount Mansfield to the current shared transmitter building. Greg helped with the transition from Analog tv to Digital TV. Times change and so does technology, but one consistent was Greg.

Greg was a booster for ABC 22 & Fox 44. He was always promoting the station and the events the station was involved with. He was the station champion for the MS-Walk fundraiser, he was always involved with their *Feed a Family* events. You could also count on him being at their annual Founders Day of Caring where the staff does community projects for local organizations.

In 2017, Greg was awarded the VAB Snyder-Tefner award for excellence behind-the-scenes. Greg's contributions can't be measured in one award or a list of accomplishments.
