WDEV Focusing on Radio News Coverage






As a news/talk station, WDEV's focus has been to keep listeners informed on the ever changing situations in their communities and how it will affect them. Starting at 3am on Monday, July 10th, they have turned their daily 7 hours of local news into flood coverage. Their talk show featured leaders from the towns affected to talk about what they have been going through and what they need. Listeners were calling in with updates on what they were seeing and the situations they were in.

During their non-news shows, they've been doing live breaking news updates several times an hour including carrying the Governor's press conferences. A FEMA representative who was on scene even called WDEV out of the blue to go on the air and update people on how to make claims.


The Point Independent Radio
